Temporary accommodation for men
experiencing homelessness in Kirklees

Who are we?

Spring Street in Kirklees provides temporary accommodation for single men, aged 16 and over, who are experiencing or are at risk of homelessness.

The hub of the project is a large 8-bed terraced house providing hostel accommodation, based in Springwood.

We also have 12 units of dispersed accommodation in Huddersfield, which provide self-contained accommodation and operate with a lower level of staff support.

What we can help you with:

- Support to find alternative, permanent accommodation or support to manage your own accommodation
- If you are moving on to independent living, advising, assisting and supporting you in this process
- Assisting you with welfare benefits claims, debt-counselling advice and developing money management skills
- Helping you develop skills and confidence in cooking and other domestic activities

- Support accessing and making referrals to local services, including health services, training and education services and substance support services
- Helping you to attend any important appointments and accompanying you, if required, to initial appointments
- Helping you apply for jobs or referring you to agencies specialising in education, training and employment
